# Sarasota County Becomes More RED as Republican Voter Registration Surges

Strong, Competent, Energized Organization Pays Off

Republican voter registration dominance continues to grow over Democrats in Sarasota County and the state of Florida.

In Sarasota County at the beginning of this year, Republicans had pushed up to a 52,987 registered voter lead over Democrats. But as of the end of June, that difference had expanded to a 57,036 voter advantage in just six months!

That 4,049 voter difference represents a 7.6% expansion of our lead just since January!

We said right after the huge election successes in the November 2022 Midterms that we were going to immediately shift back to voter registration emphasis. There can be no resting on our laurels and this diligence, combined with our tireless volunteers, continues to pay off.

And our local successes play directly into the Republican Party of Florida's continually expanding voter-registration advantage over the Florida Democratic Party.

The GOP had 5,263,269 registered voters as of June 30, while the Democratic Party had 4,721,471, according Florida Division of Elections.

That 541,798-voter edge was up from a 496,150-voter advantage at the end of

May.

Thank you to everyone for your ongoing efforts to keep Sarasota County a solidly conservative Republican county.

# Vote By Mail

Florida law now requires new mail-in ballot request each cycle.

Mail-in voting is the law and we cannot cede this ground to the Democrats. So a few things to remember:

- Sarasota County Republicans frequently beat Democrats in mail-in voting, along with early voting and day of voting, in past election cycles.
- Since that time, the Florida Legislature and Governor DeSantis have further tightened our election laws every session.
- Requesting a mail-in ballots simply gives you the option to vote by mail. You can still vote in person until and including election day by dropping off your ballot. But if a hurricane hits, and it nearly did in 2022, then a mail-in ballot allows you do to that ahead of the hurricane. There is no downside to requesting one.
